

1. The hours of operation will remain the same for all schools. There will be no visitors allowed in the buildings; only staff members will be permitted to enter the building.
2. Students must attend all of the classes indicated on their school schedules.
3. The District office will remain open following normal business hours.
4. Teachers and Instructional Aides will be providing instruction to all students synchronously.
5. In order to be marked present, your child must be online during classroom meets as designated by his/her teacher.
6. Please be sure to update your email address, home address, and telephone number by emailing your child's teacher, the school secretary, or your child's guidance counselor.
7. Please designate an area for your child to receive their virtual lessons. Have your child wear the headphones during class time.
8. As in regular, in-person school, teachers will be providing your child with assignments that must be completed. Your child's grade will be based on the completion and accuracy of these assignments.
9. Your child must have all of the required vaccines and comply with the school procedures and regulations. Even during virtual learning, your child is still in school and school staff members are obligated to notify the appropriate persons in non-compliance cases
10. Parent-teacher conferences, meetings with the guidance counselors, and student disciplinary conferences will still be available to parents. These meetings/conferences will all be held virtually.
11. If your child is having difficulty logging in and completing assignments, please contact the teacher and guidance office.
12. Your child is scheduled to return to the hybrid schedule (COHORT 1) on Monday, March 1, 2021. You will be notified via email if there are any changes in returning to the hybrid schedule.
